

## What are Aurora Doors?

Aurora Doors are a frameless sliding wardrobe door incorporating colour painted toughened glass.

## Why buy an Aurora Door?

- Different to conventional mirror, gyprock or painted MDF doors.
- Modern, contemporary look.
- Seamless and continuous colour due to the frameless system.
- Adds a dramatic feature to a room.
- Combine with Aurora V-Groove to truly make an individual statement. Refer to the Aurora V-Groove data sheet.

## Are they safe?

Absolutely. Aurora Doors are made from toughened glass which is classified as Grade A safety glass and meets Australian Standards.

The thickness of glass to be painted depends on the size of the panel. We will use either 4mm or 5mm as per the following table.

Australian Glass Standards	
Glass Thickness (mm)	Maximum (Sqm)
4	2.2
5	3.0

## What is the difference between a custom and a standard Aurora Door?

We have developed a range of standard height and width panels and also a range of standard colours. A wardrobe configured from these panels is deemed standard. All other wardrobes are custom made. Please consult an Aurora Glass sales representative for further details regarding standard and custom size Aurora Doors.

What are the benefits of standard versus custom?

The benefits of standard door over custom doors are:

- Lead time – standard panels are held in stock locally and are therefore available in a short lead time.
- Price – a custom door system will be about three times more expensive than a standard door system.

## What are the standard panel sizes?

Standard panel sizes are shown in the following table.

Standard Panel Sizes	
Height (mm)	2000
Width (mm)	Area (Sqm)
770	1.54
820	1.64
920	1.84
1070	2.14
1210	2.42

Please note: 2000mm × 1210mm panels require 5mm toughened glass, all other standard panel sizes use 4mm toughened glass.

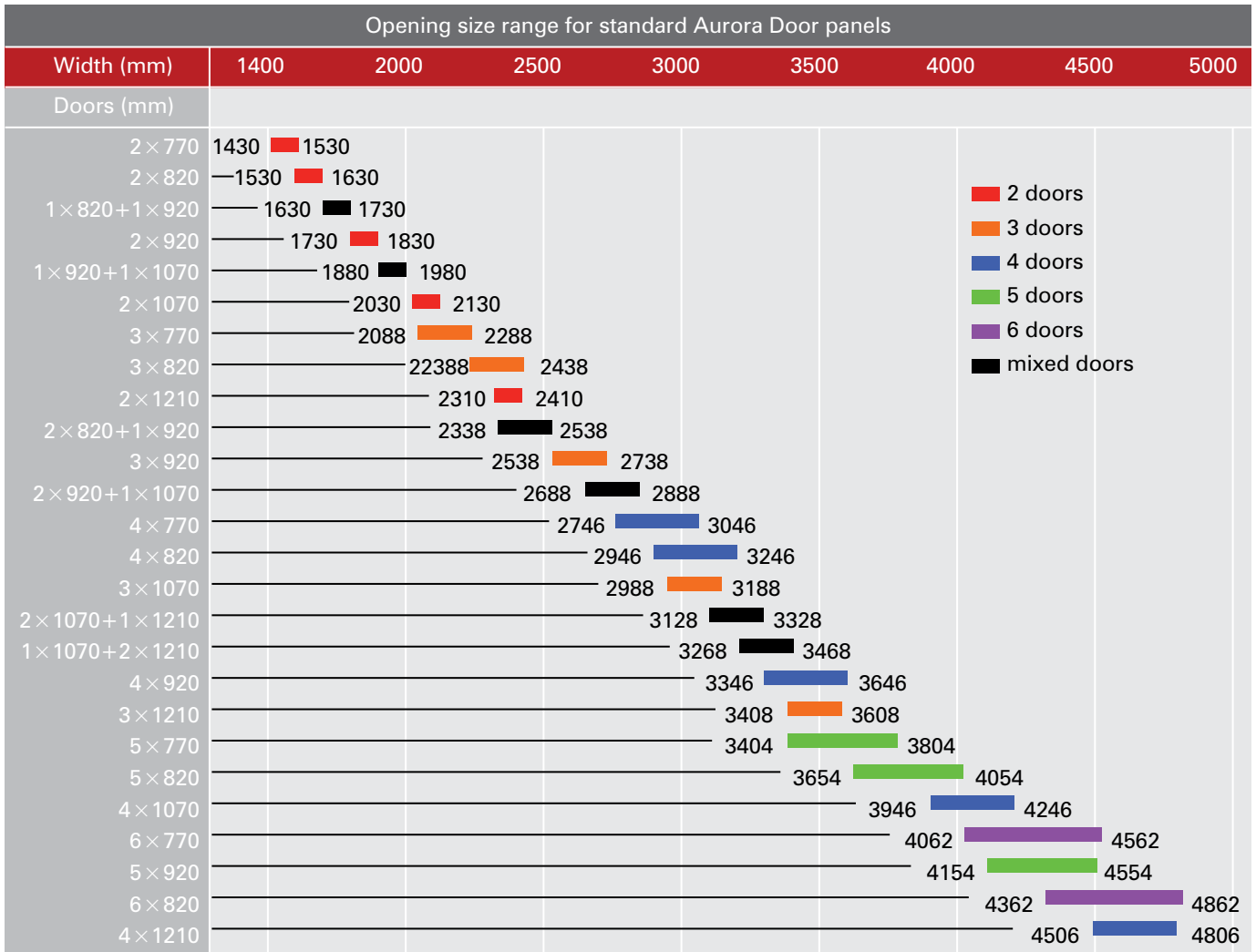
## How do we use standard panels to cover an opening?

In the chart on the reverse of this data sheet we have set out the ways in which standard panels can be combined to cover various opening sizes.

Please note that in preparing this chart:

- We have allowed for a maximum overlap of 114mm.
- The minimum overlap is 14mm.
- We have allowed for mixed sized doors in a wardrobe door system by combining one standard panel with the next size up or down. You have the option to mix door sizes, consult an Aurora Glass sales representative for more information.
- The narrower doors should be installed on the front track so that all doors remain accessible.

Aluminium and timber jambs or infills can be added to increase the opportunity to use standard door panels. When designing internals it is critical that you give consideration to the overlap and use mixed sized doors to ensure that the internals are accessible and operable.



**What are the standard colours?**

White Beige Burgundy Black Metallic Grey  
 All standard colours are painted on clear toughened float glass. Where a standard colour is chosen remember to sight a physical sample from an Aurora Glass sales representative.

**What about custom colours?**

We can match colours from colour charts of leading paint manufacturers. However, it is critical that the following is understood:

- Actual paint colours will vary from the colours on printed paint charts.
- Large expanses of a colour can look different from a small colour swatch.
- The iron in glass distorts colour giving it a greenish tinge resulting in the colour varying slightly from the colour selected. On custom colours we only use low iron glass which minimises and virtually negates this effect. In comparing quotes with other suppliers it is important that you specify this so to ensure an "apples for apples" comparison.

When specifying a custom colour the following information must be provided:

- The paint manufacturers name
- The name of the colour
- The paint code for the colour

**Lead times**

The lead times vary between products.

- Standard doors
- Custom coloured or sized doors
- Custom doors with Aurora V-Groove

Each will have different lead times that will vary from time to time. For further information please consult an Aurora Glass sales representative.

**Pricing**

Pricing for standard size panels and custom colours is available, please consult an Aurora Glass sales representative for all pricing requests.

**Guarantee**

Toughened glass, float glass, laminated glass, painted glass, high performance glass and framed mirror glass are guaranteed against defects and degradation for a period of three years, but do require ongoing maintenance to not void the guarantee.
